Please ask your student if you haven't seen the registration packet for next year. All forms and fees are due **May 10th**. Please note that the link for payment on the MySchoolBucks website has not been updated, and the forms link is still for the 18/19 school year. We will let you know when that gets corrected, but for now, please don't try to pay 2019/20 band fees on MySchoolBucks.

Concert Uniforms:

Spring Concert: We want all students looking sharp for the spring concert on May 21st! Please review the Concert Uniform Requirements (attached and also on the band web site) one last time to make sure you arrive properly attired. Also, please check your dresses and tuxedos for lost buttons, dropped hems, etc. It is your responsibility to sew on buttons, repair dropped hems, and otherwise keep your uniform clean and in good repair. If you have other problems with the uniform, please let us know as soon as possible, as we will not be doing fittings immediately prior to the concert.

We also need a few volunteers to assist us with uniforms prior to the concert. If you are able to arrive by call time, please email raenaclose@hotmail.com or cousins8@hotmail.com.

Concert Uniform Return Procedure – Everything You Ever Wanted to Know: All uniforms must be cleaned and returned to the band room. Instructions are included in the Concert Uniform Requirements (attached, and on the band web site), but we'll repeat them below as well.

Due Dates: **SENIORS** must return their uniforms to the band room the night of the spring concert (May 21st). Please bring a change of clothes so you have something to wear home. EVERYBODY ELSE (Except graduation band) must wash/dry clean their uniforms according to the instructions below and return them to the band room no later than May 31st. IF YOU ARE PLAYING IN THE GRADUATION BAND, your cleaned uniform is due back in the band room by June 13th.

Shoes, Pearls, Tux Shirts, Ties and Cummerbunds: These are yours to keep at home. If you are returning to band next year, you will be required to bring them to uniform fitting day or to purchase new ones if you cannot find them. If you are not returning to band next year, please consider donating these items as well as your band polo. There will be a donation box located in the band room.

Dresses: Your dress and garment bag must be washed before they are returned. Please leave a signed note in the back zipper pocket of the garment bag to indicate that your dress and bag have been washed. Remove the nametag from the garment bag before washing in cold water and reinsert the nametag after drying. Wash the dress in cold water on delicate cycle and hang

dry. This saves many volunteer hours washing all of the band dresses. Thanks! **Please return the hanger** with the dress.

Tuxedos: Your tuxedo must be dry cleaned and your garment bag washed before they are returned to the band room. Return the tuxedo with an attached dry cleaner receipt dated after the spring concert (or after graduation, if you play in the graduation band). The recommended dry cleaners are listed below. Please remove the nametag from the garment bag before washing in cold water and reinsert the nametag after drying. **The hanger must be returned with the tuxedo;** please do not leave it at the dry cleaner when you drop it off.

Expo Cleaners (located on Main Street, next to Goodwill): \$2.25 each piece, jacket and pants (\$4.50 total)

Pickett Road Valet (Must mention Woodson Band to receive special pricing): \$3.75 each piece, jacket and pants (\$7.50 total)
