12:00 – Arrive; unload into storage room, RR
1:00 – Clinic Session w/ Professor John Beck
2:00 – Clinic ends, students have time in Exhibit Hall
2:50 – All students report to outside performance area for load-in
3:00 – Setup and warm up begins
3:45 – Warm up ends, open hall for guests
4:00 – Performance!
5:00 – Performance concludes, change, load buses and depart ASAP
6:00 – Group Dinner in Norfolk TBD (provided)
7:30 – Depart Norfolk
10:30 – Arrive at CGW, unload, **clean room**, dismiss

- Uniform:
 - Tuxedos – Bring Dinkles, long black socks, white T-shirt, cummerbund, bowtie, tuxedo pants and jacket.
 - Dresses – long black socks, dress
 - ALL – Have a plan for your hair to look presentable all day. Long hair must be up off shoulders during performance/clinic
- Clean/polish instrument ahead of time!
- Bring extra reeds, mouthpiece caps and tuners.
- Bring snacks for bus ride.
- Students must ride the bus to and from the event. If there is an extenuating circumstance, it must be in writing and approved by the director.
